

Here at Geelong Safe and Secure we have been using Videofied systems for just over 2 years now, and have installed them in all manner of locations. Some of which include houses, sheds, factories and even a chicken farm.

No longer do you need to place the cameras on the side of a shed or house that contains the DVR unit. The sheer diversity offered through the wireless capabilities of the cameras means that any location that once would have been considered impossible, or impractical, is now perfectly possible.

The first time we used a Videofied system was for a client with a hire-service that was building a new compound, within the first week the cameras had picked up an intruder and the police arrived within minutes to apprehend him.

Thankfully this time around it turned out it was a builder who had come on-site without informing anyone or disarming the system. While not the most thrilling story, it goes to show just how effective these systems are.

As mentioned beforehand, with a Videofied system you can be a little inventive with your placement of cameras. It is possible to maneuver them into smaller spaces and non-standard locations since cabling is no longer required. We even had one client ask us to attach one of their cameras to the side of a tree in an attempt to catch people jumping his fence. And it worked to! We caught footage of them climbing the fence to intrude onto the property as well as back over again while he was fleeing.

Aside from the stories just mentioned, Geelong SAS has helped with the apprehension of suspects in many other cases. This results not only in a happy customer but the a saving of hundreds, if not thousands, of dollars in equipment or goods that remained with their rightful owners and not out in flea market stalls over 100km away.
